FAQ:

Q: What is After School Kids?

After School Kids is an irresistible, life-changing environment for 1st - 4th graders, where exploring and growing in our faith is our key focus. That's why we call it "A.S.K?" After School Kids is a fun way to gain a faith foundation and grow in a personal relationship with Jesus. But, we don't want it to just stay here, we want kids to take their wonder, and what they learn about who God is, who they are, and who they are in God with them wherever they GO!

Q: Where is After School Kids?

After School Kids is held on Wednesday afternoons at Sandersville United Methodist Church. Members of our team pick students up at their schools around 3:00 p.m. Parent pick up is at 5:45 p.m. Contact Matt if you wish to attend Wednesday Night Small Groups at SUMC at 5:55 p.m. We have created a hassle-free environment for students that includes dinner & homework/study time from 5:50-7:00 pm.

Q: When does After School Kids start?

Q: How do I sign my child up?

Signing-up your child is easy! Just fill out the registration form and return it to Sandersville UMC before your child's first Wednesday! Don't forget to make a copy of your insurance cards for our records and to choose one track for each of our three track opportunities. Please let us know before school is out on Wednesday if your child does not need to be picked up or if we should expect your child for the first time. We don't want to forget anyone!

Q: How much does After School Kids cost?

After School Kids is FREE for all students. However, providing such an amazing environment for our students does involve a great investment. The cost for supper alone is \$3/meal. Please consider making contributions to Sandersville UMC to help offset the cost of this awesome environment! Just make checks out to SUMC and put "ASK or After School" in the memo! Thank you for your support!

Q: Will you still pick my child up from school?

Yes. As long as we have a registration form for your child before your child steps on the van we are able to legally transport your child in our vans.

Q: What if my child is homeschooled or not at school?

If your child is homeschooled or your child is not available for van pick up, parents are invited to drop their child off at the playground between 3:15 & 3:30 Wednesday afternoons. Parents' schedules and students' schedules can be hectic. Please contact us if your child has a regular weekly time conflict on Wednesday afternoons. We would love to work with you to make it easy for your child to join us for at least parts of the afternoon!

Q: How and where do I pick up my child?

Parents may pick up students under the portico on the west parking lot at 5:45 p.m.

Q: Can I pick my child up early?

Absolutely! We have designed After School Kids with your child in mind and we hope he or she is able to stay for the entire afternoon. However, we realize that the time just doesn't work for some families. Please let us know as early as possible if you need to pick your child up early or if you will be dropping your child off late. And don't forget to contact us if your child has a regular weekly time conflict on Wednesday afternoons we can work around.
